Privacy Notice for Members

Who are we?

True Food Community Co-operative is a Registered Society under the Co-operative and Community Benefit Societies Act 2014 & regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA).

Our full privacy policy is explained below, but the main points are:

- We only ever ask for what we really need to know
- We collect and use the personal data you share with us transparently, honestly and fairly.
- We will always respect your choices around the data you share with us
- We will put appropriate security measures in place to protect the data you share with us
- We will never sell your data.

What will we do to ensure your data is secure?

- Train staff and members who process data
- Store data securely
- Check third party security

Why are we able to process your data?

We can only process your personal data if we have a lawful basis as defined by the Data Protection Act 2018. For True Food this is usually because we have a legitimate reason to do so.

We will only use your data for the purposes for which you have given it to us. If we have asked you for your consent, for example to receive marketing material, you can withdraw that consent at any time.

Contact

Our Business Development Lead is responsible for our data protection policies and procedures.

Your Rights

- You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal data. There are some exceptions to this but these would be explained.
- You have other rights such as erasing personal data, or restricting processing, in certain circumstances.
- We have an obligation to ensure that your data is accurate.

Data Retention

We will keep your data only as long as we have a legitimate use for it or have a contractual or legal obligation to keep it. We carry out an annual audit to ensure we comply with this. In some circumstances we will ask for your consent to process your personal data – for example to receive marketing. You can withdraw your consent at any time. In the table below we list all the legal bases for processing your personal data.
